Rationale

Main Objective

Assist Morocco in its ambition to develop and strengthen a new national quality assurance agency for higher education. The project will identify and assist in the development of the essential components of the QA system that meet national and institutional needs; a "roadmap" and a white paper establishing a reasonable transition from the current situation to international standards and expectations.









Specific objectives

- A roadmap for implementing and/or improving QA functions and procedures
- 2. A White Paper to inform on the implementation of the new QA system with recommendations to address the common needs of EQA and IQA in Morocco. It will include a 10-year "roadmap" to support the development of a quality culture.
- A shared toolbox to meet the needs of internal quality assurance and external quality assurance in Morocco that will lead to
- 4. A code of practice for quality assurance management in Moroccan universities.
